Collection and drop off

Please inform the school office if someone different is collecting your child and ensure this person knows your password. If you have forgotten your password please speak to your class teacher or school office who will help you.

What will a typical day look like in Year 1

- ▶ Your child is now in KS1 (Key Stage 1). This is different to the EYFS (Early Years Foundation Stage) which your child studied in Year R
- ▶ Daily phonics lesson introducing new sounds and revisiting taught sounds. This is the same scheme your child followed in Year R.
- ▶ Daily reading practise session - reading with teacher or TA 3 times a week
- ▶ English and maths lessons daily
- ▶ Foundation subjects - the children no longer work in the 7 areas of learning but now follow The National Curriculum

Reading

- ▶ Please read as much as possible with your child, ideally everyday. Reading unlocks learning to all other subjects.
- ▶ Reading diaries continue as in Year R. Please complete the diaries at home and make sure your child brings it to school everyday. New books will be sent home each Friday.
- ▶ Words - when your child brings words home with them please practise reading them and then practise spelling.

Memorable Experiences

- ▶ We aim to provide as many memorable experiences as possible for our children throughout the year. Below are some examples of experiences we hope to be able to offer this year.
- ▶ Mobile zoo to visit to school - September
- ▶ African drumming - October
- ▶ Pantomime in school - December
