

PE

This half term is sports day and we will be practising team games in preparation for this. We'll be running, jumping and throwing which can be rehearsed at home where safe! Parents may even want to practice their sprint start!

RE

- Describe ideas about God within the Christian and Hindu faith.

Children will be respectfully discussing what God means to different people and to themselves. Ask children how people view God differently and embrace our diverse community.

Maths

- Measurement
- Time
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and division

We will be learning to tell the time to 5 minute intervals and recall how many minutes are in an hour and hours in the day.

Children will learn how to measure to the nearest cm, litre and kg too.

We will be working on our fluency and recall in addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. Ask your child to recall their number bonds to 10, 20 and 100. Can they also give subtraction facts like $25-5=20$ mentally. Can they recite their timetables (2, 3s 5s and 10s)?

Art

- Use drawing and modelling to share ideas, experiences and imagination

Over the half term children will be making their own animation and studying artists Peter Lord, David Sproxton and Nick Park.

PHSE

- To develop personal values and recognise choices and natural consequences to these choices

We will be looking at different values that are important to different people. We will be discussing scenarios and choices available to us and what could happen as a result of our choices.

Computing

- Talk about one instance of a database being used to organise, store and use information.
- Understand and use keywords to find the best information online.

Children will learn all about how to use databases and search engines to find information.

DT

We will be learning about nutrition and food hygiene. During our George's Marvelous Medicine day and the Year 2 residential we will be chopping, mixing and following recipes to make healthy snacks. Encourage your child to help you cook in the kitchen!

Science

- Observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- Find out and describe how plants need water, light and suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy

Children will grow a variety of different plants and observe their growth and how different factors affect this process. When out walking, can your child spot and name the different parts of a plant?

English

- Handwriting
- Spelling contractions, words with suffixes, homophones and common exception words
- To use punctuation (. , ? ') accurately
- To read fluently, make inferences, answer questions and compare texts

In addition to daily reading practice, children will be listening to and reading George's Marvellous Medicine. We will be writing descriptive pieces, diary entries and role-playing scenes from the story. Continue to practise spellings at home, paying particular attention to handwriting. Ask your child what has happened so far in the story and what new vocabulary they have learnt.
