What can you do at home? What animals do you have at home? Can you talk about if the animal came from an egg, where it lives and what it eats?

What can you do at home?

Have conversations about change, positive changes in your child's life


Prompt children to talk about what they have been learning about at school.

Use the school website to support your child learning the names of other staff members.


Around the World! Summer 1
