Monday 13th May - Friday 17th May 2024 - Year 2 SATs

Part of the Key Stage I curriculum involves children sitting Standard Assessment Tests (SATs) towards the end of Year 2. These assessments fall into the following categories: maths, reading and SPAG (spelling, punctuation and grammar). Children's performance in these contributes to teacher's overall assessment of children's progress within the curriculum. SATs scores alone do not determine a child's level of progress.

This year, Year 2 will be completing their SATs in the week commencing 13th May 2024. Children will be completing these in the morning each day, so it is essential that all children are in school and on time. As with any school day, please ensure children have had a good night's sleep and nutritious breakfast to enable them to function at their best.

The children have been practicing in class so they are prepared for the week. We have been referring to them as 'quizzes' because 'SATS' doesn't mean much to children! We encourage the use of this language at home as well. The best way to support your child with these is to continue reading and spelling at home and building number fluency using the Hit the Button game https://www.topmarks.co.uk/maths-agmes/hit-the-button


The sessions are open to anyone who is involved in caring for children and those who have taken part previously all agree how incredibly beneficial it has been to their own and their family's emotional wellbeing.
