Year 1

Thursday 13th June - Money Heroes

 - Mike Teavee (second from right) - T shirt and black clothes.
 - Veruca Salt (far right) - Party dress.
- Alternatively, children can wear non-uniform and a sticky label that says the character they are (labels provided in school).

Warm Weather - Once a Day Application Sunscreen Needed for All
