

English

In English, we will be using everything we have learned to write diary entries set during the Great Fire of London. The children will use their imagination to explore how London may have looked, sounded, and felt at the time, helping them to write with empathy and detail.

Music

In music, we are planning a London-themed music workshop where the children will explore rhythm and experiment with using their voices to create and perform sounds inspired by the city.

History

We will learn all about the Great Fire of London—what happened, who was involved and how it led to changes. Ask your child about its lasting impact!



Computing

In computing, we will be learning about e-safety using the Common Sense resources. The children will focus on how to stay safe online, make responsible choices, and behave in a respectful way when using digital technology.

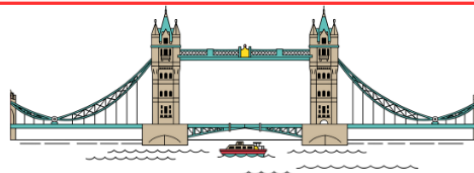


London

In the lead-up to our exciting London trip, we will be using our learning in history and geography to understand why London is an important place to us. The children will take ownership of their learning by researching London and deciding how best to present their ideas. They will then create a final product to advertise the city, which may take the form of a poster, leaflet, or video.

RE

We will be learning about both Easter and Holi, exploring their meanings, traditions, and why they are important to different communities. The children will compare how each celebration is observed and reflect on the values of joy, reflection, and togetherness that they share.



Maths

In maths, we will be focusing on fractions, as well as developing our skills in addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

PE

In PE, we will be building on our learning about sending and receiving to further develop our ball skills. The children will practise throwing, catching, and controlling a range of equipment, with a focus on accuracy, coordination, and teamwork.

Geography

We will identify landmarks in London and discuss physical and human features of London now versus during the Great Fire of London.

Our theme this half term is healthy me where we look at keeping safe and healthy. We will look at how to keep healthy both physically and mentally and how to look after ourselves
