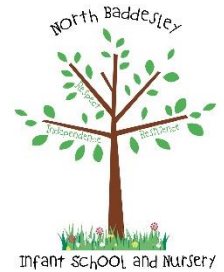

Keeping Everyone Safe

Our assembly this morning focused on reminding our children about the importance of keeping everyone safe here at school and nursery.

To support us with this, please can we ask parents and carers to ensure their children are not playing football on the playground at the start of the school day. Unfortunately, there have been a couple of accidents caused by footballs being kicked when the playground is busy with families arriving and leaving. Our children have also been reminded that they should not be going into the wooded area without adult supervision before school.

In addition, some families have informed us that bikes and scooters are still being ridden on the playground before 8:45am. Please can we all be considerate of one another to keep everyone safe.

Medicine to be Administered at School or Nursery

If your child needs to have medication administered by us during the school day or a nursery session, e.g. antibiotics, you will need to complete an 'Administration of Medicines and Treatment Consent Form'. This form is now available on our website under the 'Parents' tab, where a copy can be downloaded, completed and emailed to us: adminoffice@northbaddesley-inf.hants.sch.uk.

We hope this will help our families to complete the form remotely in advance and save them time when bringing new medication into the School Office.
