Parking at North Baddesley Recreation Ground

We have been advised by the Parish Council that work to install a new garage/groundsman's compound next to the sports pavilion will start today.

Part of the pavilion car park will be fenced off while the work is taking place so parking will be restricted (at least 2 bays by the garage area). The duration of the work is expected to be approximately 6 weeks. However, the overflow car park will be available during this time.

The Council have reassured us that they hope to keep disruption to a minimum with any deliveries taking place outside of peak school times and they apologise for any inconvenience that may be caused.

Water Safety Information

Very sadly, drowning is one of the leading causes of accidental death in children in the UK, but most incidents are preventable with the right knowledge, supervision and preparation.
